Brickhouse Farm Revetment Repairs Mundon



What are we telling you about?

We will be carrying out repairs to tidal defences at Brickhouse Farm where damage has occurred in recent years.

Where is this work happening?

The work is happening at Brickhouse Farm, Mundon, at the location indicated in red on the map below.



When are we doing the work?

We plan to start works on or after 3 May 2016. The works are expected to last for up to 1 Month. We will normally be working between 07:30 and 17:00 on Monday to Friday.

What will we be doing?

We will be repairing sections of the damaged erosion protection using an excavator to remove the existing rock and concrete blocks and replacing them with new concrete blocks.

For safety reasons we will need to close a section of the public footpath. We will provide an alternative route around the works. We appreciate this could be inconvenient, and would like to thank people in advance for their patience.

Why are we doing the work

The seawall is constructed using clay, with concrete blocks and stone to reduce the risk of erosion. In the area where we are working the erosion protection has been damaged. It is important to repair it where necessary to reduce flood risk.

How will this work benefit you?

The seawall is important in reducing the flood risk to the local area, including several residential properties. The area also provides important habitat and some parts are designated as a Site of Special Scientific Interest and a Special Protected Area.

What should you do and how can you get involved?
